Day 1:

Depart early morning after breakfast from your hunting camp for Botswana. Leave your rifles at your hunting camp for safe keeping. Travel to Nata via Francistown. This afternoon we take an open vehicle safari to the Makgadikgadi Pans National Park, which is known for its prolific birdlife. Overnight at Nata - Botswana.

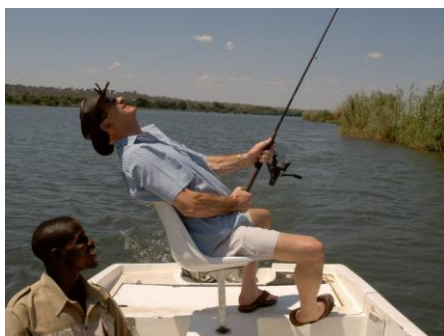
Accommodation: Nata Lodge *** (D)



Day 2:

After a leisurely breakfast we travel to Kasane, arrive in time for lunch at Chobe Safari Lodge. The rest of the afternoon and evening is at leisure, giving you time to relax and enjoy the beauty of this area or **optional** - book an afternoon **tiger fishing** on the Chobe / Zambezi River. Overnight at Kasane - Botswana.

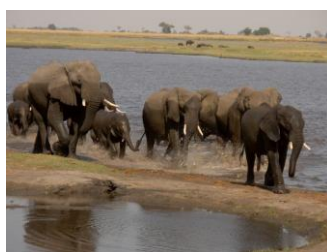
Accommodation: Chobe Safari Lodge **** (B & D)



Day 3:

Early morning open vehicle safari into “Big 4” country - Chobe National Park. You then have the rest of the day to relax at the lodge with its beautiful setting along the Chobe River or **optional - tiger fishing** on the Chobe / Zambezi River and then end off the day with a sunset cruise down the river - Chobe National Park. This area is well known for its large herds of elephant and Cape buffalo. Overnight at Kasane - Botswana.

Accommodation: Chobe Safari Lodge **** (B, D & Game Activities)



Day 4:

Cross the border at Kazungula to Zimbabwe for a visit to one of the “natural wonders of the world”, as there is no finer place to immerse yourself in the majesty of the Victoria Falls. Enjoy lunch at the “grand old lady” - colonial style Victoria Falls Hotel, before returning to Kasane for the night. Overnight at Kasane - Botswana.

Day 5:

After a leisurely morning in Kasane and a visit to the border post (river cruise), which is the only place in the world where 4 countries meet, namely Namibia, Botswana, Zambia & Zimbabwe, we then travel via Nata to Francistown. Overnight in Francistown.

Accommodation: Cresta Thapama Hotel **** (B & D)

Day 6:

This is the one day that involves quite a bit of traveling. Depart for South Africa, cross the border at the Groblersbrug border post. Collect your rifles, before travelling to Muldersdrift on the outskirts of Johannesburg & Pretoria. Dinner will be served at the Carnivore Restaurant, which is one of only two of its kind in the world.

Accommodation: Misty Hills Country Hotel **** (B & D)



Day 7:

The morning at leisure **or** we could visit the Sterkfontein Caves, also known as “The Cradle of Humankind” **or** visit Soweto - reflex on the “Apartheid” era of South Africa’s history. There will be time for last minute shopping, before we transfer you to O R Tambo International Airport in time for you to catch your flight home.

Accommodation: - (B)
